

The 72 County Strategy

Growing Wisconsin's Progressive Legacy

When Wisconsin Democrats woke up on November 7, 2012, we were delirious with joy, having secured our electoral votes for President Obama and sending Tammy Baldwin to the US Senate. But we were disappointed too, knowing that while legislative Democrats received hundreds of thousands more votes than Republicans, we were still deep in the minority thanks to the new maps rammed through by the Republican legislature.



As we debriefed and dissected the results over the next few months, we came to some important conclusions that are guiding our work this year.

- 1. Wisconsin is a swing state, not a red state, and Wisconsinites cast significantly more votes for Democrats statewide in the last election.
- 2. State legislative districts are less favorable to Democrats after GOP-controlled redistricting, but we can win back the State Senate and make significant gains in the State Assembly if we start working in 2013.

- 3. Doing this work in 2013 talking to voters, training our grassroots leaders, recruiting and supporting local candidates and building up a local media presence will not only help all Democratic candidates win in 2014, but will help us build our long-term strength for 6, 8 and 10 years down the road.
- 4. This work has to happen in each and every one of the 72 counties in our state.

And thus, the 72 County Strategy was born

Regional Political Director Program

Through the 72 County Strategy, the Democratic Party of Wisconsin is making an unprecedented off-year commitment to taking backing critical State Assembly and State Senate districts, defeating Scott Walker in 2014 and laying the groundwork for Democratic victories for the next decade.

Regional Political Directors - currently based in Fox Valley, Chippewa Valley and Southwestern Wisconsin - are the first boots on the ground in this new effort. Working with local leaders, they have been tasked with creating a regional campaign plan that pairs the most sophisticated campaign practices with local knowledge about what works and what doesn't in each community in our state.



They're working right now on organizing volunteers to talk to Wisconsinites about the key issues facing our state, building local media teams that can bring the Democratic message to every region of the state and training grassroots volunteers to use the powerful data tools we have at our disposal to win campaigns.

By the end of 2013, we've asked our Regional Political Directors to identify Community Captains who will take ownership over getting out the vote in key swing wards statewide. To do that, they'll be working closely with our new in-house Data Director to identify the wards that we'll need to carry in order to win in our highest priority targets, using the advanced targeting practices employed by the Obama campaign.



Winning at the Local Level

Our regional staff are also working with county party leaders and other progressive organizations on a series of specialized trainings for candidates and campaign managers on the fundamentals of winning spring races.

Throughout this summer and fall we'll be working with local leaders on assessing and targeting races for April 2014 and developing the plans we need to win.

Winning locally not only builds the bench for future elections, but also strengthens our county party infrastructure and gives activists a way to ensure that their progressive values are reflected at every level of government.

Red to Blue Badgers

The DPW's commitment to Democrats in every corner of the state continues to grow every single day. Through the development of an innovative new Red to Blue Badger Program, the DPW is training and supporting grassroots candidates in conservative districts, to keep pressure on Republicans and spread our progressive message to the reddest corners of the state.

The Red to Blue program is designed to help Democratic candidates in these overwhelmingly red districts by giving them the resources and infrastructure to build a successful campaign. By creating benchmarks in key organizational areas such as field and finance, this initiative aims to not only assist these candidates, but also establish a more efficient and successful working relationship between party and candidates in these tough districts.

The 72 County Strategy marks a turning point for Democratic grassroots organizing in Wisconsin. While the Republicans may be able to outspend us, they will never be able to out organize us. By working to win now, the DPW is committed to helping every Democrat up and down the ticket be ready to win in 2014 and beyond.


