NOW, MORE THAN EVER, WISCONSIN NEEDS A LEADER LIKE MARY BURKE.



A fourth-generation Wisconsinite, Mary Burke is Wisconsin through and through. Her commitment to the people of the state is endless and she'll work every day to better the lives of her fellow residents in the Badger state.

Her approach to business and politics is rooted in values of humility and hard work. Her father started their family bike manufacturing business in a barn in Waterloo. Trek, the once small-time bicycle start-up, is now a global leader in the industry and employs nearly 1,000 people in great, family-sustaining jobs right here in Wisconsin.

Mary grew up wanting to be a businessperson just like her father. His entrepreneurial spirit is in her blood, and it helped propel her to earn degrees from Georgetown University and Harvard Business School.



As a businesswoman, Mary is no stranger to success. She headed up Trek's European expansion, and in just three years expanded her division's sales from \$3 million to \$50 million. About ten years ago, Mary made the decision to resign from Trek in order to dedicate her time and her talents to bettering the community and was unanimously elected President of the Boys & Girls Club of Dane County. Through Mary's leadership and advocacy, the organization has increased the number of children it serves from 300 to 3,000 and watched its operating budget grow from \$250,000 to \$3.5 million.



Her results led to her being named Commerce secretary under Governor Jim Doyle. As secretary Mary took a solutions-oriented approach, seeking out all of the possible options and working with anyone – Democrat or Republican – who could help create more jobs and opportunity for all Wisconsinites. During her tenure Wisconsin's unemployment rate never topped 4.8%, and Wisconsin had 72,000 more jobs than it does today.

Outside of business and politics, Mary is committed to Wisconsin and her community. She believes in sharing the fruits of her success and it isn't out of the ordinary for her to quietly donate her own money to support non-profits and charity programs. But make no mistake, Mary's support doesn't stop with financial resources – she is an active and engaged participant in the execution of programs that benefit our communities. Mary founded AVID/TOPS, a student achievement partnership with the Madison school district designed to close the achievement gap. In just four years, students enrolled in the program have shown academic progress, graduation rates are up, and more low-income students and students of color are going to college.


