Thu, Apr 16, 4:00-5:00pm

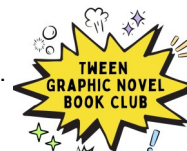
Taquitos is a group of tweens who meet every month to work on special projects for the library.

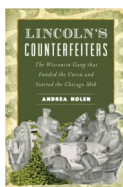
Meet up with other fiber art enthusiasts, learn new techniques, exchange ideas, or find inspiration for your next project.
